Canada. } hundred and fifty-two
of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, assented to on the twenty-sixth day of June in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, and intitled "An Act respecting the Criminal Law", being chapter 51 of the Statutes of 1953-54, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Our Governor in Council.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the said Act should come into force and have effect upon, from and after the first day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.

Now KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force and have effect upon, from and after the first day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.

OF ALL WHICH Our Loving Subjects and all others whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: The Honourable PATRICK KERWIN, Chief Justice of Canada and Deputy of Our Right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor, Vincent Massey, Member of Our Order of the Companions of Honour, Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada.
