**Subject: Investigation: *Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act and the Criminal Code***

Mr. Elliott:

This letter is a formal request for an investigation by the RCMP into my allegation that government members have not followed the provisions of the *Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act*, S.C. 2007, c. 30 and have thus committed an offence under subsection 126(1) of the *Criminal Code*, disobeying a statute.

As background material, see: my letters to Mr. Saunders, the Director of Public Prosecutions and the service's replies at [www.lareau-law.ca/droitpenal\\_.htm](http://www.lareau-law.ca/droitpenal_.htm), Part VII, last items; the *2009 Spring Report of the Commissioner of the Environment and Sustainable Development*, chapter 2; and the Federal Court decision of *Friends of the Earth*, 28 October 2008, a civil matter (presently, there is a request for a permission to appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada).

Please inform me who will investigate my complaint. In view of the sensitive nature of the investigation, I trust that you will give the investigative staff the required independence, protection and support to proceed free of any interference. Such an investigation leading possibly to the laying of charges is important for the respect of the rule of law. The contravention of the *Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act* can cause serious harm to the environment and human life, legal interests that the public interest requires that they be protected. I trust your leadership will ensure that the police investigative process will be fully respected.
