CHAPTER 136.

An Act respecting the Department of National Defence.

SHORT TITLE.

1. This Act may be cited as the Department of National Short title. Defence Act. 1922, c. 34, s. 1.

INTERPRETATION.

- 2. In this Act and in any orders and regulations made Definitions. hereunder, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) "Department" means the Department of National "Department." Defence;
 - (b) "Deputy Minister" means the Deputy Minister of "Deputy Minister." National Defence;
 - (c) "Minister" means the Minister of National Defence; "Minister."
 (d) "prescribed" means prescribed by this Act, or by "Preregulations made hereunder. 1922, c. 34, s. 2.
- 3. There shall be a department of the Government of Depart-Canada which shall be called the Department of National ment and Minister of Defence, over which a minister of the Crown shall preside, National who shall be the Minister of National Defence. 1922, c. 34, Defence.
- 4. The Minister shall be charged with all matters re-Services lating to defence, including the Militia, the Military, Naval, included. and Air Services of Canada. 1922, c. 34, s. 4.
- 5. There shall be a Deputy Minister of National Deputy Defence, who shall be appointed by the Governor in Minister. Council.
- 2. Such officers, clerks and employees as are necessary officers, for carrying on the business of the Department may be clerks, etc. appointed in the manner authorized by law. 1922, c. 34, s. 5; 1918, c. 12.
- 6. The Governor in Council may make such orders and Regularegulations as are deemed necessary or advisable for the tions. proper and efficient administration and organization of the Department. 1922, c. 34, s. 6.
