HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL, on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice, pursuant to subsection 4(2) of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1977, is pleased hereby to order that a proclamation do issue declaring the period commencing November 1, 1978 and ending on November 30, 1978 to be a firearm amnesty period during which no person who delivers a firearm or other offensive weapon to a peace officer, local registrar of firearms or firearms officer for registration or destruction or delivery to the Solicitor General or the Attorney General of a province is, by reason only of the fact that he was in possession of such firearm or weapon prior to such delivery or by reason only of the fact that he transported such firearm or other offensive weapon for purposes of such delivery, guilty of an offence under any of sections 83 to 106 of the Criminal Code as they read before the coming into force of section 3 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1977, or of an offence under Part II.1 of the Criminal Code as enacted by section 3 of that Act.
