Dear Mr. Lareau:

This letter acknowledges your formal complaint, a copy of which is enclosed.

The legislation requires that the RCMP conduct the first investigation into complaints. The legislation also obligates the RCMP to send you a letter acknowledging your complaint no later than 45 days after being notified of the complaint and monthly status reports thereafter during the course of the investigation. The investigator will then prepare a summary of your complaint and ask you to sign an RCMP complaint form.

The RCMP can try to resolve the complaint informally which requires the consent of both you and the RCMP member involved. If both parties are satisfied, the RCMP will record how it was resolved on an RCMP complaint form. You will be asked to sign the form. Make sure that you agree with the summary before you sign it. If you have any questions about the process, call the Commission and a staff person will assist you.

If there is no informal resolution, the RCMP will proceed to an investigation. The RCMP will send you reports on a regular basis to inform you of the status of their investigation. When the investigation is complete, the RCMP will send you a letter that summarizes the results of its investigation. The letter will also tell you what action, if any, the RCMP has taken or plans to take to address your complaint.

If you are not satisfied with the way the RCMP handled your complaint or the outcome, you can request a review by this Commission, which is an independent agency. The RCMP is obliged to provide this Commission with all of the relevant information regarding your complaint and will thoroughly assess all material such as witness statements, and medical records prior to issuing a final report.

My complaint is that the RCMP failed "to investigate my allegation that government members have not followed the provisions of the *Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act*, S.C. 2007, c. 30 and have thus committed an offence under subsection 126(1) of the Criminal Code, disobeying a statute".

I believe that it is in the public domain that the *Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act* has not been followed. There was sufficient *prima facie* evidence to conduct an investigation.
