Subject: Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act (KPIA)

Request for an investigation

Thank you for your fax on March 1, 2010 in which you ask Assistant Commissioner Allen Nause to review Superintendent Burke's decision.

Superintendent Burke's decision was based on evaluation of your allegation, research, and taken in consultation with the Public Prosecution Service regarding the information you provided. The Federal Court of Appeal found that the government had complied with the one justiciable matter, that is, in preparing the Climate Change Plan. As a result there is no evidence to support an allegation that the government has breached its duties under the *Kyoto Protocol Implementation Act* over which the courts have any authority. Therefore, based on your information and given the findings of Federal Court, there is no offence prompting the conduct of an investigation under subsection 126(1) of the *Criminal Code*.

The RCMP mandate includes the authority to prioritize investigations and best utilize our limited resources to serve the public interest.
